







## Formative Assessment Digital Tools

 <p><a href="https://getkahoot.com/">https://getkahoot.com/</a></p>	<p>Kahoot! empowers educators and captivates learners. Through the creation of a trusted learning space, educational content is delivered by asking meaningful questions in real-time, creating a social, fun and game-like environment.</p>
 <p><a href="https://backchannelchat.com/">https://backchannelchat.com/</a></p>	<p>Backchannel Chat is a class discussion tool that was designed from the ground up to support teachers. Backchannels are great for increasing participation in classroom discussions and for informally assessing your students' knowledge.</p>
 <p><a href="https://www.zaption.com/">https://www.zaption.com/</a></p>	<p>Add images, text, and questions to any online video, creating interactive lessons that meet your learners' needs.</p>
 <p><a href="http://www.socrative.com/">http://www.socrative.com/</a></p>	<p>The teacher creates an account and a room (for, you guessed it, free). Then the students go to the site (either through the app or through a browser), enter the room number and they see a question or an open response question to answer. I like this one a lot because of the variety of choices for questions to answer. One is even called exit ticket where kids can quickly summarize what they learned and tell you what they need for tomorrow.</p>
 <p><a href="https://www.peardeck.com/">https://www.peardeck.com/</a></p>	<p>Pear Deck allows a teacher to take a PowerPoint, Google Presentation, or PDF and incorporate various student activities to check for understanding and engagement. Pear Deck is free for students and teachers (with a higher end, paid premium model) and it fully integrates with Google Apps for Education.</p>
 <p><a href="https://padlet.com/">https://padlet.com/</a></p>	<p>These provide a virtual corkboard for students to leave notes of questions or comments on their learning. They are easy to set up and free. Best part, kids don't have to have an account to leave a note and they can do it anytime, anywhere. All they need is the address.</p>
